
## EIB Art Tour, Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> January 2026 from 17:45, Headquarters of the European Investment Bank

The collection consists mostly of European contemporary art and is complemented by Old Masters, 19th century and modern pieces.

Mrs Delphine Munro has been the Head of Arts & Culture at the EIB since 2009, in which capacity she is also the curator of the institution's extensive art collection, involving exhibitions at the EIB and internationally. She created and manages the innovative EIB Artist Development Programme, accelerating talent.

She also chairs the Casino Luxembourg - Forum d'Art Contemporain and is the President of the International Association of Corporate Collections of Contemporary Art.
